1. Gifted and Talented Award (International Students)

Up to 100% Tuition Fee Waiver for Foundation + Bachelor's Degree Studies

The 'Gifted and Talented Scholarship Programme' is a prestigious award programme that recognises and supports outstanding young people who demonstrate exceptional abilities, accomplishments, and potential in various fields, including business, design, fashion, film, games design, journalism, multi-media, software engineering, technology, engineering, and other areas. The scholarship is awarded annually by the Limkokwing Foundation as part of its Founder's Day Celebrations. It supports gifted and talented young people pursuing foundation + bachelor's degree studies at the university. Those who have completed their A-level or pre-university studies (or equivalent qualifications) may apply for this award to support their bachelor's degree studies. The Gifted and Talented Scholarship provides significant financial support, networking opportunities, mentorship, and other resources to help the recipients pursue their academic and career goals and positively impact their communities and the world.

Award Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applications for this award are open to all individuals, except for Malaysian citizens.
2. Applicants must have attained a minimum CGPA of 3.50 for the high school qualification utilised for admission to their selected bachelor's degree programme.
3. This award is based on actual academic results.
 - a. Students currently enrolled in Cambridge/Pearson Edexcel A-Level or O-Level programmes (both local and international) can apply for the mentioned Scholarship; however, final eligibility approval will be based on their final/official transcripts.
 - b. For Cambridge A-Level or O-Level, students should submit the statement of results, allowing Limkokwing University to verify the authenticity of their results via the official Cambridge website.
 - c. A list of qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA) is attached for International Students.
4. Applicants must submit an English essay of not more than 500 WORDS detailing the applicant's achievements, aspirations, and how the scholarship will assist them to "*Be the Best*". This slogan is an inspirational quote from Limkokwing University's Founder, the Late Tan Sri Dato' Sri Paduka Limkokwing. This is your chance to demonstrate your creativity.
5. For the creative-based programmes of study, students must submit their portfolio of past artwork.
6. Having received a national/international academic or arts award will contribute positively towards assessing this award.
7. Students who pass the initial selection process will be invited for a selection interview. Interviews may be conducted online for candidates outside the Klang Valley or residing overseas.
8. Successful applicants must commence their studies at Limkokwing University of Creative Technology in 2024.
9. Recipients must not hold financial assistance from other organisations and/or institutions during the award's tenure.
10. The Award is solely for tuition fees within the student's selected combination of foundation and bachelor's degree programme. Recipients must register as Limkokwing University of Creative

Technology students, pay the registration fee, and commit to paying all applicable resource fees to be eligible to apply for the Gifted and Talented Award.

11. To continue receiving their Gifted and Talented Award, the recipient must maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.50 throughout their study duration.
12. Recipients receiving a Gifted and Talented award must serve 10 hours per semester in various roles, including acting as an ambassador of Limkokwing University of Creative Technology at various events to continue their award in subsequent semesters.
13. Recipients must agree to feature in promotional material supporting this award programme and the university.
14. Candidates must confirm their scholarship acceptance within seven (7) calendar days, failing which, it will be automatically withdrawn.

2. Wings Scholarship: Empowering the Next Generation (International Students)

Up to 100% Scholarship for those with a health impairment or from the lower socioeconomic group.

The Wing's Scholarship Programme empowers students from challenging personal circumstances to pursue their academic and career ambitions. Recipients will receive up to 100% tuition scholarship for their selected pre-university programme PLUS bachelor's degree programme (i.e., foundation/diploma + bachelor). This scholarship follows the tradition of the late Tan Sri Dato' Sri Paduka Limkokwing philanthropic endeavours to empower through education those with life challenges through a "hand-up, rather than a hand-out".

Award Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applications for this award are open to all individuals, except for Malaysian citizens.
2. Applicants must have attained the minimum admission requirements for their selected programme(s) of study.
3. This award is based on actual academic results. This award is based on actual academic results.
 - a. Students currently enrolled in Cambridge/Pearson Edexcel A-Level or O-Level programmes can apply for the mentioned Scholarship; however, final eligibility approval will be based on their final/official transcripts.
 - b. For Cambridge A-Level or O-Level, students should submit the statement of results, allowing Limkokwing University to verify the authenticity of their results via the official Cambridge website.
 - c. Students holding other qualifications can refer to the attached list of qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA) for International Students.
 - d. This opportunity is exclusively available to candidates currently residing in their home country.
4. Applicants must be able to demonstrate, with documented proof, **either**:
 - a. Lower Socioeconomic Group:
 - Submit proof of family income (e.g., tax returns, income statements) and/or
 - Documentation demonstrating financial hardship, such as statements of government aid or assistance **OR**
 - b. Health Impairment:

- Provide a medical certificate or documentation from a recognised health institution detailing the nature and extent of the impairment.
5. Applicants must submit an English essay of not more than 250 WORDS detailing the applicant's achievements, aspirations, and how the scholarship will aid them to "Be the Best".
 6. For the creative-based programmes of study, students must submit their portfolio of past artwork.
 7. Having received a national/international academic or arts award will contribute positively towards assessing this award.
 8. Students who pass the initial selection process may be invited for a selection interview at the selection panel's discretion. Interviews may be conducted online for candidates outside the Klang Valley or residing overseas.
 9. Successful applicants must commence their studies at Limkokwing University of Creative Technology in 2024.
 10. Recipients must not hold financial assistance from other organisations and/or institutions during the award's tenure.
 11. The award is solely for tuition fees for the student's selected pre-university + bachelor's degree programme combination. Recipients must register as Limkokwing University of Creative Technology students, pay the international registration fee, international administration fee, EMGS fee and pay all applicable resource fees to be eligible for a Wings Scholarship.
 12. To continue receiving their award, the recipient must maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.0 throughout their study duration.
 13. Recipients receiving this award must serve up to 10 hours per semester in various roles, including acting as an ambassador of Limkokwing University of Creative Technology at various events to continue their award in subsequent semesters.
 14. Recipients must agree to feature in promotional material supporting this award programme and the university.
 15. Candidates must confirm their acceptance of the scholarship within seven (7) calendar days, failing which, it will be automatically withdrawn.
